

Resurrection Rolls – Snack (To be used in Session 7)

6e

Ingredients

can refrigerated crescent dough

sugar

cinnamon

butter

large marshmallows

Directions

- Preheat oven to 375°F. *Read John 19 while the oven is heating.*
- Spray a cookie sheet with cooking spray or line with parchment paper.
- Unroll crescent dough and separate each triangle. *This is like the cloth they wrapped Jesus in.*
- Have children dip marshmallow in melted butter. Roll in cinnamon and sugar mixture. *The marshmallow represents Jesus. The butter, cinnamon, and sugar are like the oil and spices used to prepare a body for burial.*
- Place marshmallow in the top of the crescent roll and roll into a crescent roll shape, then secure the sides by tucking them under and pinching them closed. *This is a picture of how they wrapped Jesus' body when they put him in the tomb.*
- Place on prepared cookie sheet.
- Bake in preheated oven for 8–10 minutes or until golden brown on the outside. *The oven is like the tomb. Read John 20:1-18 while the rolls are baking.*
- Open the tomb (the oven) and remove the rolls. Cool. If the marshmallows have seeped out, remove the sugary bits.
- Let cool for a few minutes and then let the children pick a roll to open up. *What happened to the marshmallow? The marshmallow has disappeared, just like Jesus did when he was resurrected.!*
